How Kavanagh House Came to Be



SISTER EVE KAVANAGH, CO-FOUNDER

"When you give with your heart to something that is important to you, you never lose, you only gain. You only gain."

Central Iowans began embracing home hospice care in 1977 when a pint-sized, bicycle-riding nun named Sister Eve Kavanagh came to Des Moines.

A nurse and native of Ireland, Sister Eve had a mission to create specialized care for the dying. Her message was embraced by a small yet passionate group of volunteers in Des Moines. In 1978 Hospice of Central Iowa (now EveryStep) received non-profit status and began providing home hospice care for individuals and their families.

After providing home-based hospice care to patients for more than a decade, the organization realized the need for a 24-hour residential facility to serve hospice patients and families. An innovative 12-bed hospice house opened in 1993 on 56th Street in Des Moines. It was named Kavanagh House to recognize Sister Eve's contribution as the enthusiastic nurse and educator who introduced hospice care to Central Iowa.

While much has changed since 1993 when Kavanagh House on 56th Street was built, our goals for patient and family care remain true to the original mission:

- To sustain a sense of independence, individuality, self-worth and dignity
- To provide quality services 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- To provide compassionate care to the **whole** person, meeting physical, emotional, psychological, spiritual and social needs
- To support each individual and family with an approach that is directed by them
- To envelop families with support, help them navigate complicated decisions and provide them with grief support
- To ensure the dying can find comfort in the place they call home and in the homelike environment that Kavanagh House provides
- To earn the trust that individuals, families and the community place in our hands

Kavanagh House Deck Expansion



A larger back terrace and deck will be created so that patients can be outdoors. Extra-wide glass doors will allow patient beds to be easily moved outside.

Kavanagh House Interior Renovation and Redesign



Patient rooms will be updated with new paint, flooring, furnishings, art and "Smart" technology. They will be homelike and restful.



The Spa Room will include a spa tub and equipment for transferring patients into the tub for relaxation and comfort. Two new shower areas will be added for family members who choose to stay around the clock with their loved one.



The Kavanagh House kitchen will be upgraded to provide the equipment and resources necessary for creating individualized meals for each patient — breakfast, lunch, dinner and snacks.
