

Glass Insulator Candle Holder or Vase

Items needed:

Glass insulator
Vintage mattress spring (or make your own using wire)*
Wire strippers/cutters
Pocket knife
Gloves
Tealight or herbs/blooms

Instructions:

- 1. For the wire we purchased, we used a pocket knife to cut open the wire insulation, then removed the paper inside the insulation and separated the wires. We used the copper wire.
- 2. Wearing gloves to protect against sharp ends, wrap the wire around the insulator in a circular shape.
- 3. Pull the wire down from the small, closed end of the insulator and position wire to create a base.
- 4. Add a tealight or plants.

*We purchased the wire from Habitat for Humanity ReStore for \$1.00. You could also use sturdy craft wire or a vintage mattress spring.
