



## **Glass Insulator Candle Holder or Vase**

### **Items needed:**

Glass insulator

Vintage mattress spring (or make your own using wire)\*

Wire strippers/cutters

Pocket knife

Gloves

Tealight or herbs/blooms

### **Instructions:**

1. For the wire we purchased, we used a pocket knife to cut open the wire insulation, then removed the paper inside the insulation and separated the wires. We used the copper wire.
2. Wearing gloves to protect against sharp ends, wrap the wire around the insulator in a circular shape.
3. Pull the wire down from the small, closed end of the insulator and position wire to create a base.
4. Add a tealight or plants.

*\*We purchased the wire from Habitat for Humanity ReStore for \$1.00. You could also use sturdy craft wire or a vintage mattress spring.*
