

Glass Vase Transformation

You will need:

Glass/ceramic vase or jar

Spray primer – make sure it is labeled for use on glass or ceramics

Mixing cup

Paints in desired colors – we recommend at least three colors

Chip brush – this works well for adding texture

Flour

Instructions:

- 1. Spray primer over the exterior and inner lid of the vase. Let dry thoroughly.
- 2. Mix the base color paint with 1-2 tsp. of flour in a mixing cup. You will want to experiment with the amount of flour you add to create the texture you want. The mixture should be thick, but spreadable. Use this mixture to cover the inner rim of the vase, too.
- 3. After the base coat has dried thoroughly, apply the second paint color in the same manner. You will create more texture by using a "tapping" motion, rather than a brush stroke.
- 4. After the second paint color has dried, add the third in the same manner. You may continue with as many colors as you desire. We used variations of brown/rust to create a terracotta look.
- 5. Enjoy!
