

Ornament Wall Decoration

You will need:

Round tray or other circular object with sides

Faux tin tiles

Wood block – we used an ink stamp that we found at EveryStep Giving Tree, which we painted.

Spray paint

Hot glue gun

Additional strong adhesive to attach wood block to tray.

Embellishments

Instructions:

- 1. Spray paint the tray and (if desired) the faux tin tile.
- 2. When paint is dry, place the wrong side of the faux tile under the tray. Trace the bottom of the tray onto the tile and then cut it out to fit the tray.
- 3. Use spray glue or hot glue to attach the faux tile to the bottom of the tray. Don't be concerned if the tile doesn't exactly fit the tray bottom. If it's too small, use embellishments to cover the gaps. You could also tape tiles together on the backside to create a larger surface to trace and cut.
- 4. Paint the wood block and let dry.
- 5. Using strong adhesive (we used construction glue), attach the wood block to the tray to create the "top" of the ornament.
- Embellish your creation as desired.
- 7. Using hot glue or other strong adhesive, attach a rope or other device to hang the ornament.
