



Purse Planter

You will need:

Purse
Plants
Planting soil
Plastic bag or sheeting
Spray adhesive
Scissors
Gloves

Instructions:

1. Attach plastic bag or sheeting to the interior of the purse with the adhesive spray. Do this by sections, starting with the bottom, then each side separately. (Using this plastic will help prevent mold from forming in the fabric interior of the purse.)
2. Cut away the remainder of the plastic, so that it sits about an inch below the top of the purse.
3. Using the scissors or another sharp object, cut drainage holes into the bottom of the purse. Be sure to cut through the plastic, too.
4. Use the potting soil and arrange your plants as desired.
5. Water and enjoy!
