Dignity and Compassion Found with EveryStep Hospice

Michelle Book has experienced the compassionate care of EveryStep Hospice twice — first with her husband, Woody, in 2021 and then with her father, Marv, in 2024.

When Woody's cancer progressed, he chose EveryStep's in-home hospice care to spend his final days with family and friends in peace. Three years later, Michelle turned to EveryStep again when her father was diagnosed with advanced colon cancer. Marv needed 24/7 care, so Michelle contacted Kavanagh House, where he was quickly admitted. Marv enjoyed tranquil moments, watching deer through the window and receiving personalized care from aides and nurses who went above and beyond to ensure his comfort.

Marv passed away with dignity on March 17. "He had a wonderful end of life because of Kavanagh House, and that gives me peace," says Michelle. "Hospice helps patients and families live each day fully, making it the best it can be." Michelle recommends EveryStep to anyone in need of compassionate and dignified care.

Bridging the Gap in Maternal Health Equity

Morghan, a former standout high school athlete and scholar, found crucial support through EveryStep's Doula program after learning she was pregnant. In Iowa, Black women face stark health disparities. They are six times more likely than white women to die from childbirth-related complications, yet three out of five deaths are preventable. Jazzmine Brooks, a doula specializing in supporting Black mothers worked with Morghan. Jazzmine highlights the unique cultural connection they share, acknowledging Black women often struggle to feel heard and understood in healthcare. "We're navigating a system that isn't built to support us," Jazzmine explains.

For Morghan, this cultural bond is vital. "There's a certain understanding with Jazzmine, someone who looks like me. As a single mom, it's comforting not to feel alone and have support by my side."

Jazzmine believes in Morghan's strength, saying, "Black women do so much with so little. Sometimes, we just need a bit more support. I have full faith in Morghan and her ability to thrive as a mother."

Grief Groups Help Students Process Loss

Children experience grief for many reasons, including the loss of a loved one, divorce, moving, or even a parent's job loss. Alyssa Halferty, an elementary school counselor in Des Moines, partners with EveryStep's in-school grief groups to help children process these emotions and learn healthy coping skills needed for life.

"Grief comes in so many forms — it's not just someone died and you feel sad," Alyssa explains. EveryStep's Amanda the Panda program provides dedicated time for students to focus on their grief. This support helps prevent grief from affecting their schoolwork and removes the stigma around talking about loss.

"These groups encourage kids to share memories while enjoying fun activities, making it easier to open up," Alyssa says. EveryStep also equips families with resources to navigate tough conversations. "I'd love to see more schools use EveryStep. I love working with them, and so do our kids."
